## **Father John's Corner**

#### Diocesan Missions to the Philippines - Are you being called?

The Peace and Social Justice Ministry of the Diocese of Joliet (Illinois) announces the formation of medical and construction teams to serve in *Borongan* on the island of *Samar* and in the Bacolod area on the Island of *Negros* in the *Republic of the Philippines*. This mission will leave on February 1st and return on February 16<sup>th</sup>, 2013. This will be the ninth mission to this Southeast Asian Nation.

Physicians needed include the following surgeons: General, Plastic, ENT, Orthopedic and Pediatric surgeons. We will also need six persons to administer anesthesia (MD's or CRNA's) as well as operating room nurses and recovery room nurses. We are also looking for Staff Nurses, preferably Filipino, to teach post-op care.

In addition we are hoping to find Pediatricians and/or Pediatric Nurse Practitioners. Family Practitioners, Internists, ER doctors and Dentists are also needed.

For the Bacolod team, we are also looking for men and women who would like to assist local people in building homes for the poor. No special construction skills are necessary, just willing hands and a warm heart.

In addition to the people we need, we also ask your prayers. Gifts of surgical supplies will be greatly appreciated.

An INFORMATION EVENING will be held on Thursday, June 28<sup>th</sup>, 2012 at 7:00 PM at the St. Charles Pastoral Center , 101 West Airport Rd., Romeoville .

The selection committee is expected to choose the team by July 19, 2012.
