

The Eucharist is the source and summit of our faith. It is the saving Sacrifice of Christ our Lord, made present to us in the celebration of the Holy Mass, and communicated most intimately through devote reception of Holy Communion.

The timeline of this National Eucharistic Revival is as follows: Year of Diocesan Revival—June 19, 2022 to June 11, 2023 Year of Parish Revival—June 11, 2023 to July 17, 2024

National Eucharistic Congress—July 17-21, 2024 (Indianapolis, Ind) Year of Going out on Mission –July 21, 2024 to Pentecost 2025
