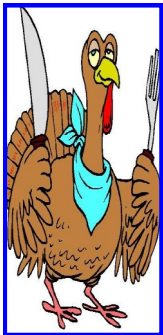
**Tuesday, November 1**—Mass at 8:00 am (Our Lady of Lourdes), All Saints Day; is a Holy Day of Obligation in the Catholic Church. The feast is held on November 1, each year commemorating all Christian saints, known and unknown. It was first celebrated by Pope Boniface IV in 608. The term saint stems from the Latin, "Sancti" which means "holy ones." What the church looks for in venerating a saint is not a faultless or sinless life, but a passionate and single-minded dedication to prayer and good works that makes this person an exemplary model of heroic virtue in some respect. The reason for the invocation of saints to ask their intercession is the doctrine of the communion of saints, that is, the belief that there is a communication with the dead by prayer and that those who have gone before can also pray efficaciously for the living. **Wednesday, November 2, 2022, The Holy Souls in Purgatory/Faithful Departed.** This is not a Holy Day of Obligation. The Church commemorates all her faithful children who have departed from this life but have not yet attained the joys of heaven. St. Paul warns us that we must not be ignorant concerning the dead, nor sorrowful, "even as others who have no hope ... For the Lord Himself shall come down from heaven ... and the dead who are in Christ shall rise. The Church has always taught us to pray for those who have gone into eternity. Even in the Old Testament prayers and alms were offered for the souls of the dead by those who thought "well and religiously concerning the resurrection." It was believed that "they who had fallen asleep with godliness had great grace laid up for them" and that "it is therefore a holy and wholesome thought to pray for the dead, that they may be loosed from sins." We know that a defiled soul cannot enter into heaven.
