Daily Reflections from the Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska

To the Full

When I (**Saint Faustina**) received Holy Communion, I said to Him, "Jesus, I thought about You so many times last night," and Jesus answered me, And I (**Jesus**) thought of you before I called you into being. "Jesus, in what way were You thinking about me?" In terms of admitting you to My eternal happiness. After these words, my soul was flooded with the love of God. I could not stop marveling at how much God loves us (Diary, 1292). On my way to the veranda, I went into the chapel for a moment. My heart was plunged in profound adoration, praising God's incomprehensible goodness and His mercy. Then I heard these words in my soul: I am and will be for you such as you praise Me for being. You shall experience My goodness, already in this life and then, to the full, in the life to come (Diary, 1707).

(**Prayer**) Lord Jesus, may I think of You and praise and thank You more fervently and constantly in anticipation of what You have prepared in Heaven for me and all those who love You!

Please try to pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet every day at 3:00pm for this is when Our Lord Jesus Christ gave us his life for sins. If you cannot pray at that time, take at least a moment at 3:00pm to feel the inconceivable, abundant Mercy that falls from heaven every day at 3:00pm for the whole world. **Jesus, I Trust In You!**

Novena of the Immaculate Conception November 30th to December 8th

The Novena to the Immaculate Conception is a custom that flourished in the Church as a way of preparing for the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception on December 8th. St. Josemaria Escriva encouraged everyone to practice this devotion. During the novena (means 9 days), we can also help our family members, friends and acquaintances to come closer to Jesus Christ through Mary reminding them, as St. Josemaria Escriva said: "You are not alone. — Neither you nor I can ever find ourselves alone. And even less if we go to Jesus through Mary, for she is a Mother who will never abandon us"
