



What do each of the candles on the advent wreath mean? The *first purple candle* is called the Prophecy Candle or Candle of Hope. The second purple candle is the Bethlehem Candle or the Candle of Preparation. The *third (pink)* candle is the Shepherd Candle or Candle of Joy. The *fourth candle*, *a purple one*, is called the Angel Candle or the Candle of Love. And the last (*white*) *candle* is the Christ Candle. The fourth Sunday of Advent is December 18, 2022

Help me to live this day in eternal hope knowing Jesus will come again. *Heavenly Father, give me the strength to have the same trust in You that Mary had, as she awaited the birth of Jesus. *I pray for humility today, Father. 


Daily Reflections from the Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska


