A Latin phrase, meaning "Totally Yours," it is a week-long "parish mission" for our Catholic youth, 1st-12th grades. It is taught through skits, songs, games, and inspiring, interactive teaching by a dedicated group of 4 college students and seminarians.

Where? When?

This year, **Totus Tuus will take place at Father Kirk Hall, during the week of July 6th-12th.** It consists of a day program for youth 1st-6th grades, and an evening program for 7th-12th grades.
