

When St. Faustina was assigned to a different house (Convent) she wrote:
(St. Faustina) When I complained to the Lord that He was taking my help away and that I would be alone again and would not know what to do,
I heard these words: (Jesus) Do not be afraid; I am always with you (Diary, 627)
(St. Faustina) When I entered the chapel for a moment that same evening, to thank God for all the graces He had bestowed on me in this house, suddenly God's presence enveloped me.
(St. Faustina) I felt like a child in the hands of the best of fathers, (St. Faustina) and I heard these words: (Jesus) Do not fear anything. I am always with you. (Diary, 629). March 22, [1936]. When I (St. Faustina) arrived at Warsaw, ...

I submitted myself in all things to His holy will. I heard these words: (Jesus) Fear nothing; all difficulties will serve for the fulfillment of My will (Diary, 634).

(Prayer) Lord Jesus, when a new situation enters my life, may I hear Your consoling words: Fear not; I am with you.

The month of **March** is known as the **Month of St. Joseph** and is punctuated by the Solemnity of St. Joseph, Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and the Stepfather to Jesus. St. Joseph's feast day is on March 19th. The adoptive father of Jesus lived his own Lent. His life was full of joy but

also of the Cross. The tradition speaks of seven sorrows of Joseph.

1) When he believed that he had to separate from his Immaculate Spouse

2) When he saw the Child Jesus born in such poverty

3) When he was pierced with sorrow to see the blood shed by the Redeemer in His circumcision

4) When with the prophecy of St. Simeon, he learned what Jesus and Mary would have to suffer

5) When he suffered to provide well for the subsistence of Jesus, particularly during the flight to Egypt


6) When he returned from Egypt in fear of Archelaus

7) When he lost his Son and sought Him without success for three days
