

The Triduum The first day of the Paschal Triduum is **Holy Thursday**, on which the Church commemorates the institution of the Holy Eucharist by Christ, as the institution narrative states, "on the night before He died." Although the word triduum is Latin for "three days," liturgically Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Paschal Vigil on the night of Holy Saturday are considered one day. This is why there is no final blessing after the Mass of the Lord's Supper, no sign of the Cross is made at the beginning nor the end of the Liturgy of Our Lord's Passion on Good Friday (making it the only day of the year on which the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is not offered) and the Easter Vigil does not begin with the Sign of the Cross either.


