

The word Eucharist comes from the Greek word eucharistein, which means "thanksgiving." (Thanksgiving means; expression of gratitude, especially to God:reverence • revering • worshipping • veneration • venerating • adoration)

It is the memorial sacrifice of Christ's body, blood, soul, and divinity truly presented under the form of bread and wine. It is offered to the Father in heaven for the forgiveness of our sins. The Eucharist is a sacrament, an outward expression of an inward reception of grace. The Eucharist differs from the other sacraments in an important way because it "is 'the source and summit of the Christian life. The Catechism goes on to say, "For in the blessed Eucharist is contained the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Christ himself, our Pasch" (CCC 1324). What a truly precious gift we as Catholics are blessed to receive Jesus Christ into our very own bodies when we consume the Holy Eucharist
