

Devotion fore the Month of May

The Blessed Virgin Mary—The Queen of May—May Crowning Back in the Middle Ages, many Catholics began observing special devotions around a particular theme each month. Today, many Catholic Churches and families are reviving this practice as part of the way they observe the liturgical calendar at home. By practicing monthly devotions, the core values of the Catholic faith will become more alive within you and your family.

Pope Gregory XVI revived the practice of May Crowning in 1837 which is now the standard practice for crowning. "Images are venerated 'not because of a belief that these images themselves possess anything of divinity or power, but because the honor shown them is directed to the prototypes they represent' (Council of Trent, session 25)" [BB, no. 1258].

Parishes will have a procession of young children to crown an image of the Blessed Virgin Mary with flowers or a crown. This often is referred to as a "**May Crowning**." This rite may be done on solemnities and feasts of the **Blessed Virgin Mary**, or other festive days, and offers the Church a chance to reflect on Mary's role in the history of salvation.^[15] In some countries, it takes place on or about May 1, however, in many United States Catholic parishes, it frequently takes place on Mother's Day.

The excitement of the celebration is the moment when one of the young children places the crown or flowers on Mary's head accompanied by a traditional hymn to the Blessed Mother. Even today many Catholics, trying to achieve a more spiritual prayer life with Mother Mary offer special presents in the month of May, such as visits to churches dedicated to her, like "Our Lady of Lourdes "or "St. Mary's". Offering little sacrifices in her honor, in addition trying to be more conscious about praying the Holy Rosary. We can also bring flowers to church and place them at her feet. There will be vases all month long around the stature of Mother Mary where you may place your flowers.

Divine Mercy — Refresh This Heart of Mine

The Lord said to me, (St. Faustina) My daughter, do not tire of proclaiming My Mercy. In this way you will refresh this Heart of Mine, which burns with a Flame of pity for sinners. Tell My priests that hardened sinners will repent on hearing their words when they speak about My Unfathomable Mercy, about the compassion I have for them in My Heart. To priests who proclaim and extol My Mercy, I will give wondrous power; I will anoint their words and touch the hearts of those to whom they will speak (Diary, 1521).

(Prayer) Lord Jesus, I want to refresh Your Heart by unfailingly proclaiming Your Mercy. Thank You for empowering Your priests with anointed words of Mercy that touch the hearts of the people. Remind me, Lord, to pray for priests that they would not stint in proclaiming Your Mercy. Please try to pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet every day at 3:00pm for this is when Our Lord Jesus Christ gave us his life for sins. If you cannot pray at that time, take a least a moment at 3:00pm to feel the inconceivable, abundant Mercy that falls from heaven ever day in at 3:00pm for the whole world.
