



Your Resting Place

I (St. Faustina) heard a voice coming from the Host: (Jesus) Here is My repose. During Benediction, Jesus gave me (St. Faustina) to know that soon a solemn moment would take place on this very spot. I (Jesus) am pleased to rest in your (St. Faustina) heart, and nothing will stop Me (Jesus) from granting you graces. This greatness of God floods my (St. Faustina) soul, and I drown in Him, I lose myself in Him, I am melting away in Him ... (Diary, 1136).

June 1, 1937. Today, the Corpus Christi procession took place. At the first altar, a flame issued from the Host and pierced my (St. Faustina) heart, and I heard a voice, here is My (Jesus) resting place (Diary, 1140). During Holy Mass, which was celebrated by Father Andrasz, I (St. Faustina) saw the Infant Jesus who, with hands outstretched toward us (congregation), was sitting in the chalice being used at Holy Mass. After gazing at me (St. Faustina) penetratingly, He spoke these words: (Jesus) As you see Me in this chalice, so I dwell in your heart (Diary, 1346).

Please try to pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet every day at 3:00pm for this is when Our Lord Jesus Christ gave us his life for sins. If you cannot pray at that time, take at least a moment at 3:00pm to feel the inconceivable, abundant Mercy that falls from heaven every day at 3:00pm for the whole world.


