

### National Eucharistic Revival

The United Bishops, under the leadership of Bishop Andrew Cozzens, have put forth a three year plan to revive our understanding of and devotion to the Most Holy Eucharist ! The Eucharist is the source and summit of our faith. It is the saving Sacrifice of Christ our Lord, made present to us in the celebration of the Holy Mass, and communicated most intimately through devote reception of Holy Communion.

The timeline of this National Eucharistic Revival is as follows:  
Year of Diocesan Revival—June 19, 2022 to June 11, 2023  
Year of Parish Revival—June 11, 2023 to July 17, 2024  
National Eucharistic Congress—July 17-21, 2024 (Indianapolis, Ind)  
Year of Going out on Mission –July 21, 2024 to Pentecost 2025

### August -Month of the Immaculate Heart of Mary

Our Lady was created literally "**Full of Grace**" as the Archangel Gabriel declared at the Annunciation, meaning that her soul was literally adorned with all of the virtues at the moment of her conception, as well as all the gifts and fruits of the Holy Spirit.

This fullness of grace is said to emanate from the center of her being—her heart—understood both physically and spiritually. It is Mary's heart, in its unspoiled created perfection, that is the source and wellspring of her purity . . . therefore her heart is called **Immaculate**.

Our Lord took His sacred humanity from the flesh and blood of his Blessed Mother; Christ's heart is taken from her heart. At Calvary, the perfect hearts of Jesus and Mary were united for the salvation of mankind. And this is why the Two Hearts are honored together.



Daily Reflections from the  
Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska

**You are Sovereign**

During this retreat, I (**Jesus**) Myself will direct your soul. I want to confirm you (**St. Faustina**) in peace and love. And so, the first few days passed by. On the fourth day, doubts began to trouble me (**St. Faustina**): Is not this tranquility of mine false? Then I (**St. Faustina**) heard these words, (**Jesus**) My daughter, imagine that you are the sovereign of all the world and have the power to dispose of all things according to your good pleasure. You have the power to do all the good you want, and suddenly a little child knocks on your door, all trembling and in tears and, trusting in your kindness, asks for a piece of bread lest he die of starvation. What would you do for this child? Answer Me, My daughter. And I (**St. Faustina**) said, "Jesus, I would give the child all it asked and a thousand times more" (Diary, 229).

**(Prayer)** Lord Jesus, thank You for directing our souls in times of retreat and prayer. Since You are sovereign over the whole world, direct our prayer and lives according to Your will. Thank You for Your astounding goodness to us in our need
