The timeline of this National Eucharistic Revival is as follows: Year of Diocesan Revival—June 19, 2022 to June 11, 2023 Year of Parish Revival—June 11, 2023 to July 17, 2024 National Eucharistic Congress—July 17-21, 2024 (Indianapolis, Ind) Year of Going out on Mission –July 21, 2024 to Pentecost 2025
