

Daily Reflections from the Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska

You Alone, Lord

Once, I (*St. Faustina*) suddenly saw Jesus in great majesty, and He spoke these words to me: (*Jesus*) My daughter, if you wish, I will this instant create a new world, more beautiful than this one, and you will live there for the rest of your life. I answered, "I (*St. Faustina*) don't want any worlds. I want You, Jesus. I want to love (You-Jesus), with the same love that (You-Jesus) have for me. I beg (You-Jesus) for only one thing: to make my heart capable of loving (You-Jesus). I am very much surprised at Your offer, my Jesus; what are those worlds to me (St. Faustina)? Even if (You-Jesus) gave me a thousand of them, what are they to me? You know very well, Jesus, that my heart is dying of longing for You. Everything that is not (You-Jesus) is nothing to me." ... Then I heard these words: (*Jesus*)With no other soul do I unite Myself as closely and in such a way as I do with you (*St. Faustina*), and this because of the deep humility and ardent love which you have for Me (Diary, 587).

(**Prayer**) Dearest Jesus, like St. Faustina, I want to desire only You. I want to live now and in eternity with humble obedience to Your will — out of a love that is on fire for You alone.


October- the Month of "Holy Rosary"

The Patchwork team of Catholic Ships were commanded by Spanish Admiral John of Austria supported by the Spanish commanders Don Luis de Requesens y Zúñiga, Don Álvaro de Bazán, and Genoan commander Gianandrea (Andrea) Doria. These Ships were powered by the Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Knowing that the Christian forces were at a distinct material disadvantage, the Holy Pontiff, St. Pope Pius V called for all of Europe to pray the Rosary for victory. We know today that the victory was significant, prevented

the Islamic invasion of Europe, and evidenced the Hand of God working through Our Lady. At the hour of victory, St. Pope Pius V, who was hundreds of miles away at the Vatican, is said to have gotten up from a meeting, went over to a window, and exclaimed with supernatural radiance: "The Christian fleet is victorious!" and shed tears of thanksgiving to God. What you may not know is that one of three admirals commanding the Catholic forces at Lepanto was Andrea Doria.
